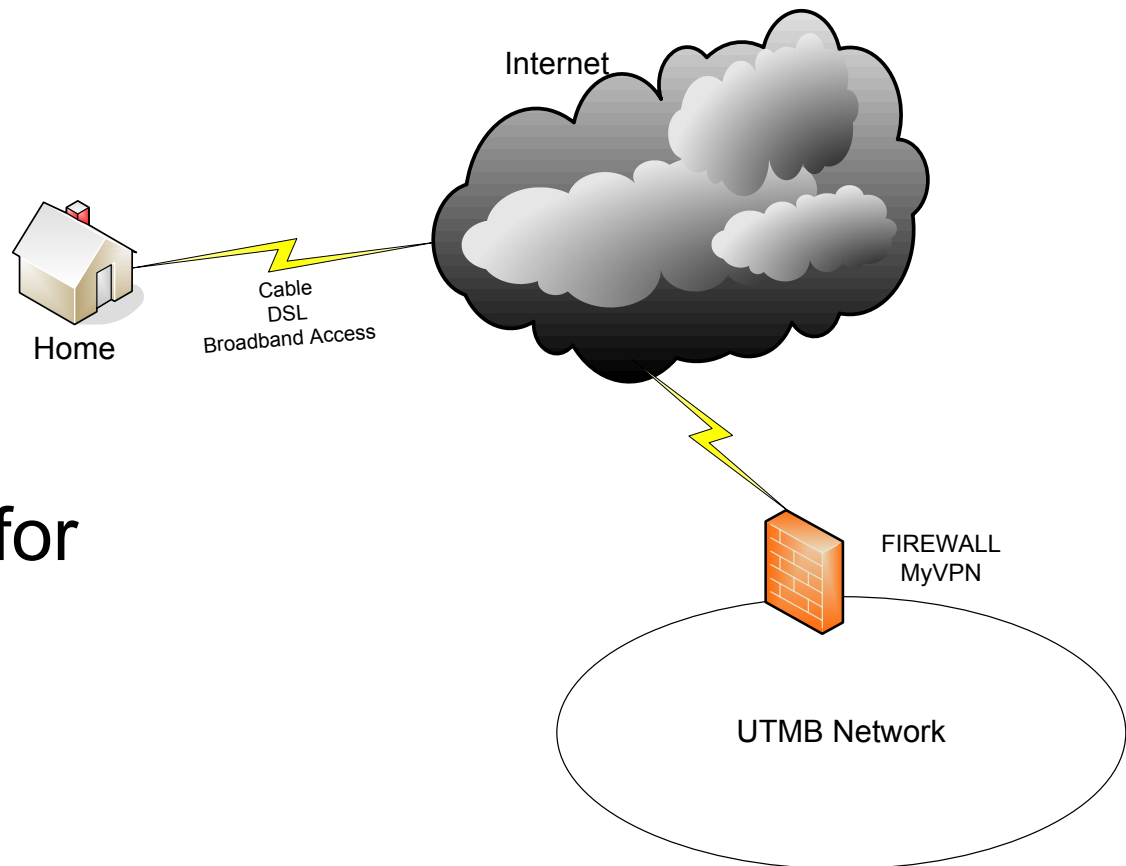



- Can be accessed using a web browser (be sure to allow pop-ups and ActiveX controls)
- Can't be blocked by ISPs (uses ports 80/443)
- Client (shim) is auto-installed
