

Declaration of Scholarship Eligibility

State law requires each student applying for a scholarship from the University of Texas Medical Branch-Galveston to identify any relationship to a current Board of Regent member. A student who is related to a current member of the governing board of that institution is prohibited from receiving scholarships unless the scholarship is awarded exclusively based on prior academic merit or is an athletic scholarship. It is a Class B misdemeanor to file a false statement.

- A Regent's spouse; spouse's child, spouse's mother or father; child's spouse; or parent's spouse
- A Regent's spouse's brother or sister; spouse's grandparent; spouse's grandchild; brother or sister's spouse; grandparent's spouse; or grandchild's spouse
