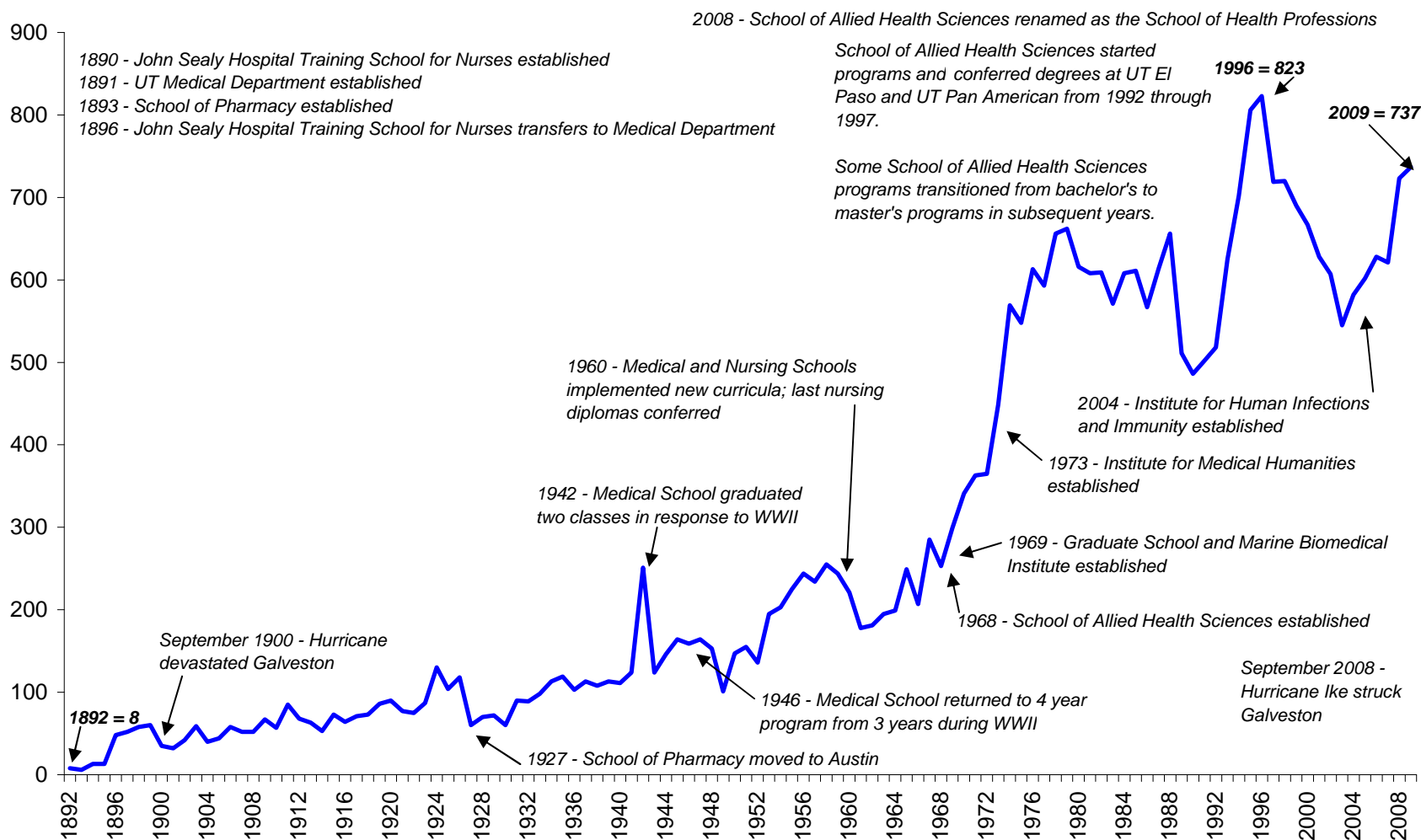




Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees, Diplomas, and Certificates Conferred 1892–2009

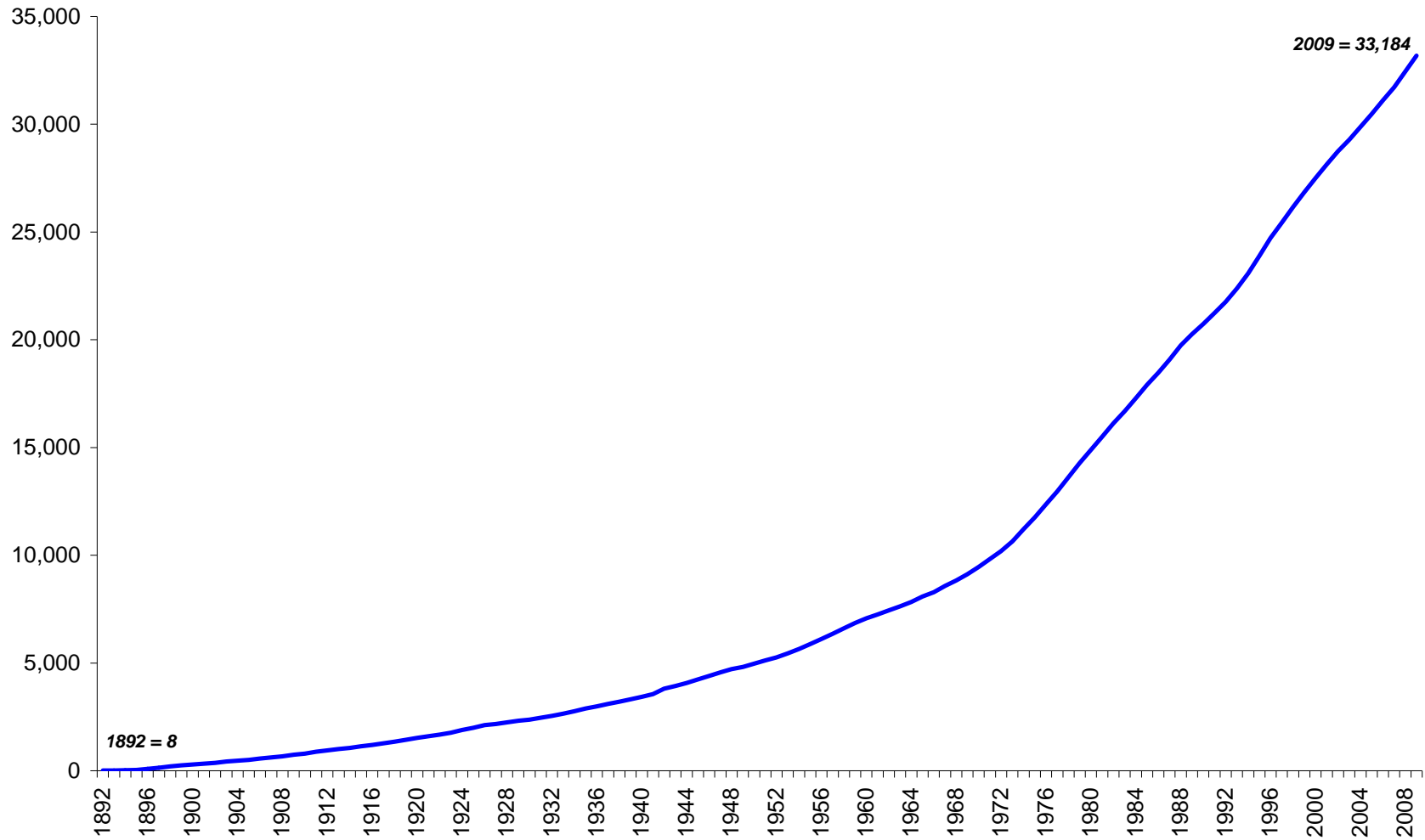

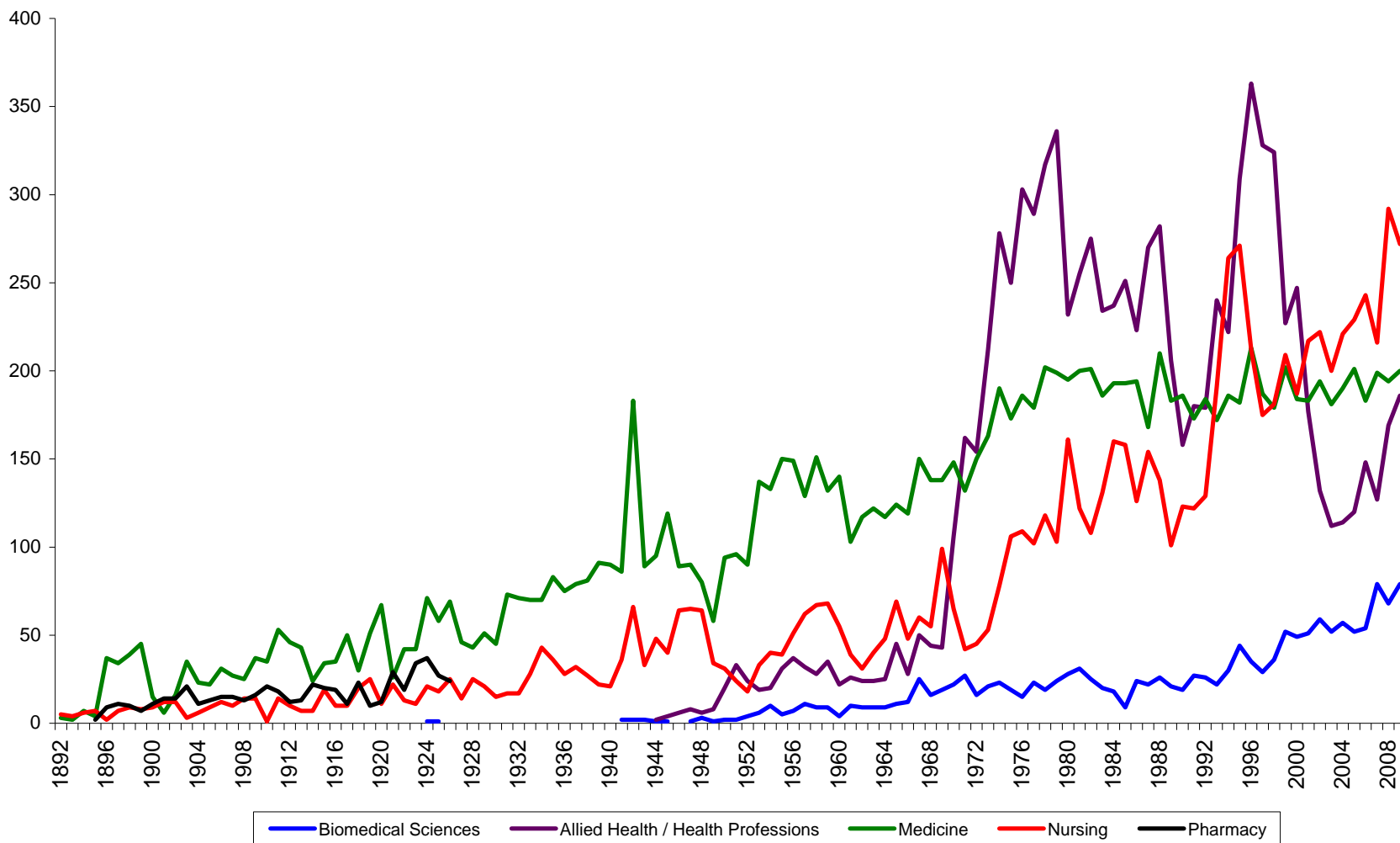
Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees, Diplomas, and Certificates Conferred 1892–2009 Cumulative Total by Year

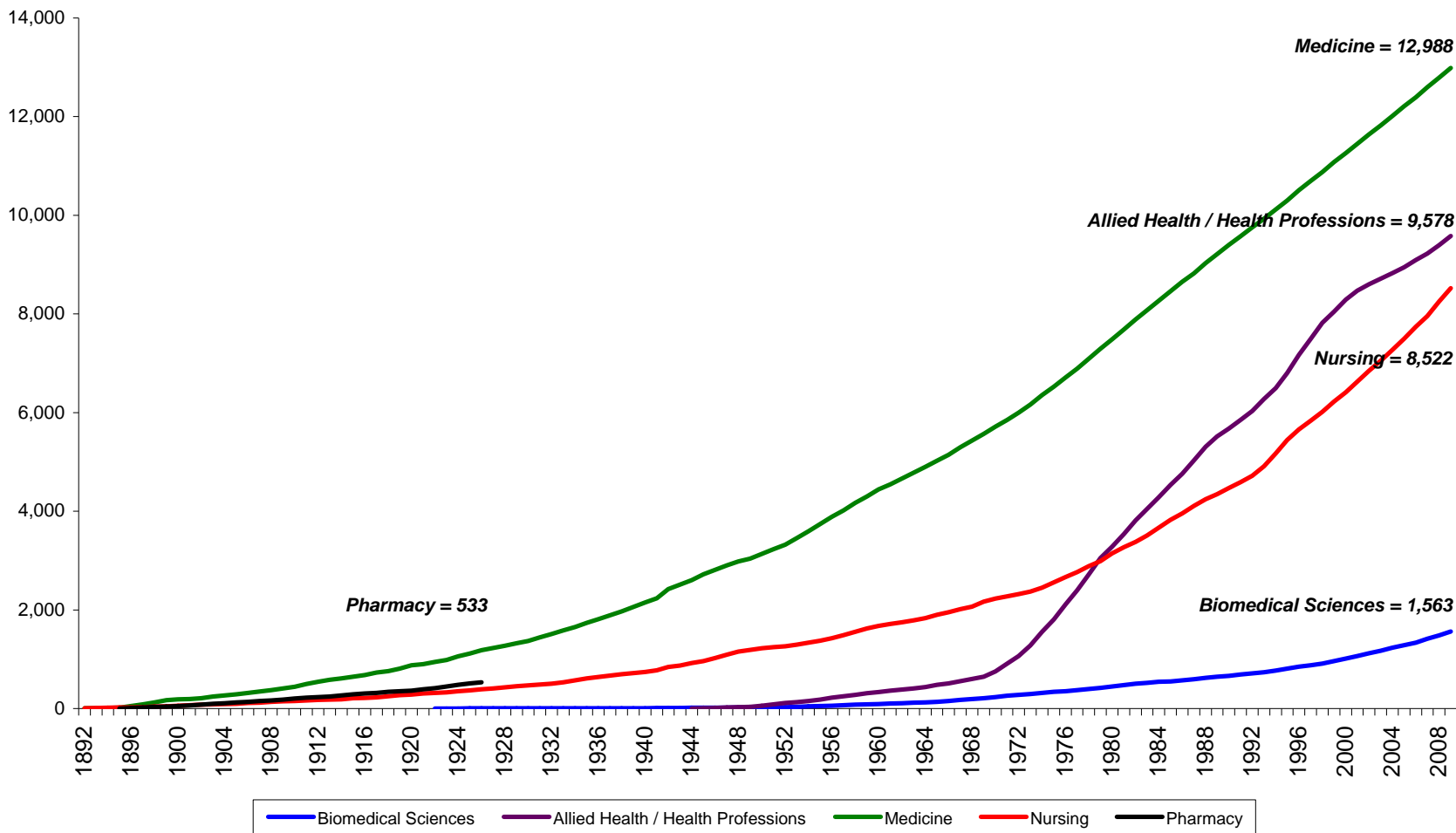
**Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees, Diplomas, and Certificates Conferred

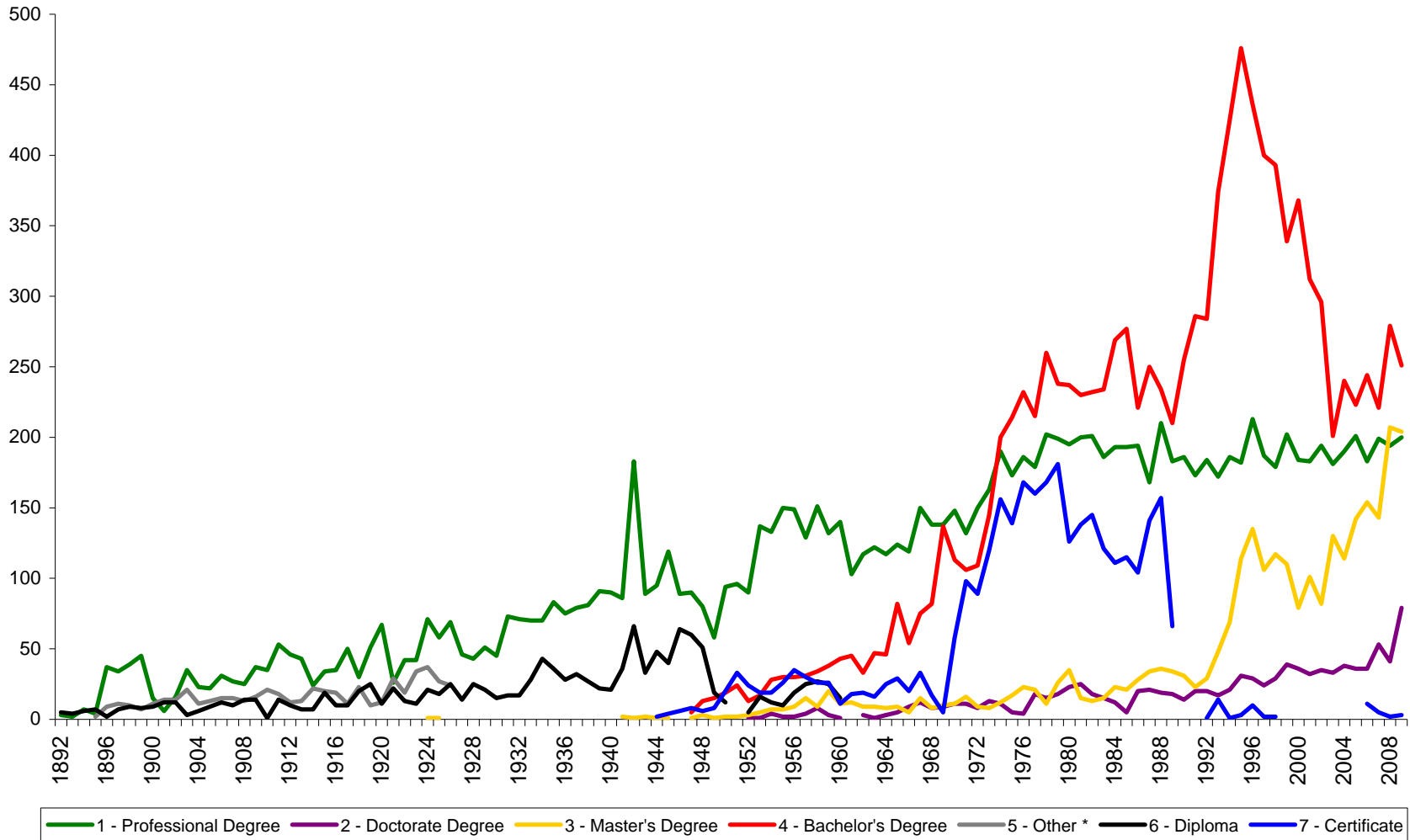
**Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees, Diplomas, and Certificates Conferred

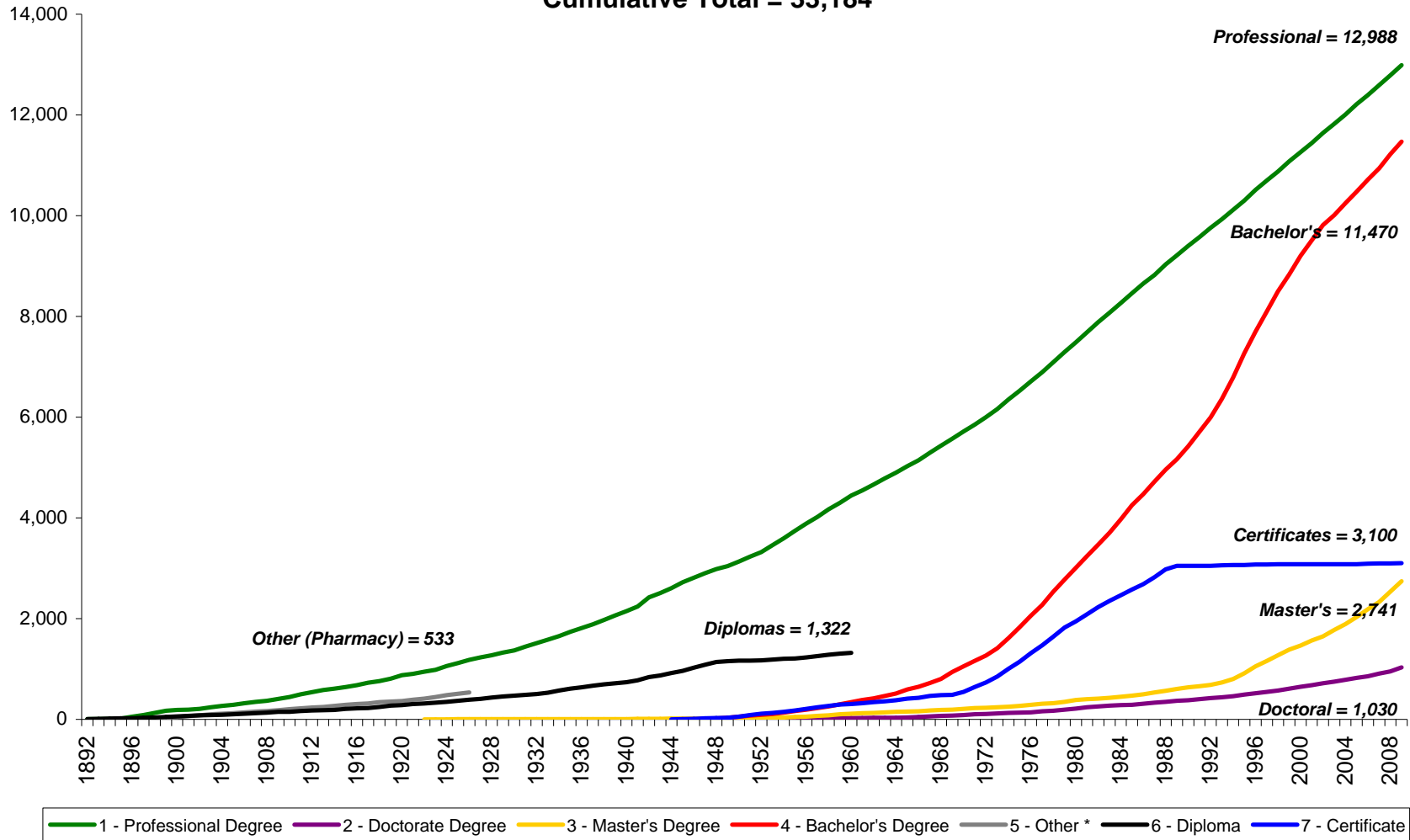
Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees, Diplomas, and Certificates Conferred by Level 1892–2009 Cumulative Total = 33,184
