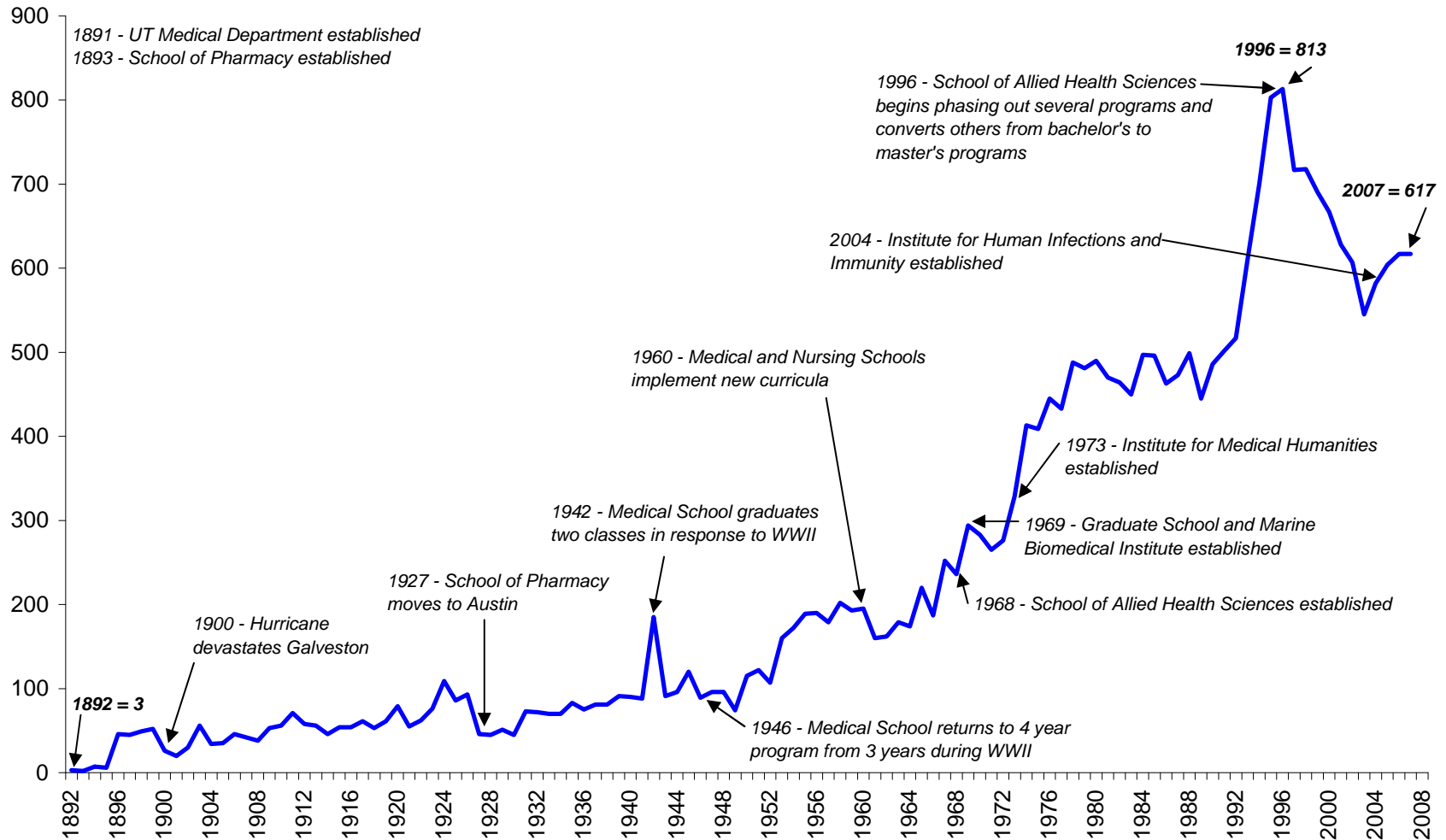




## Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees Conferred 1892–2007

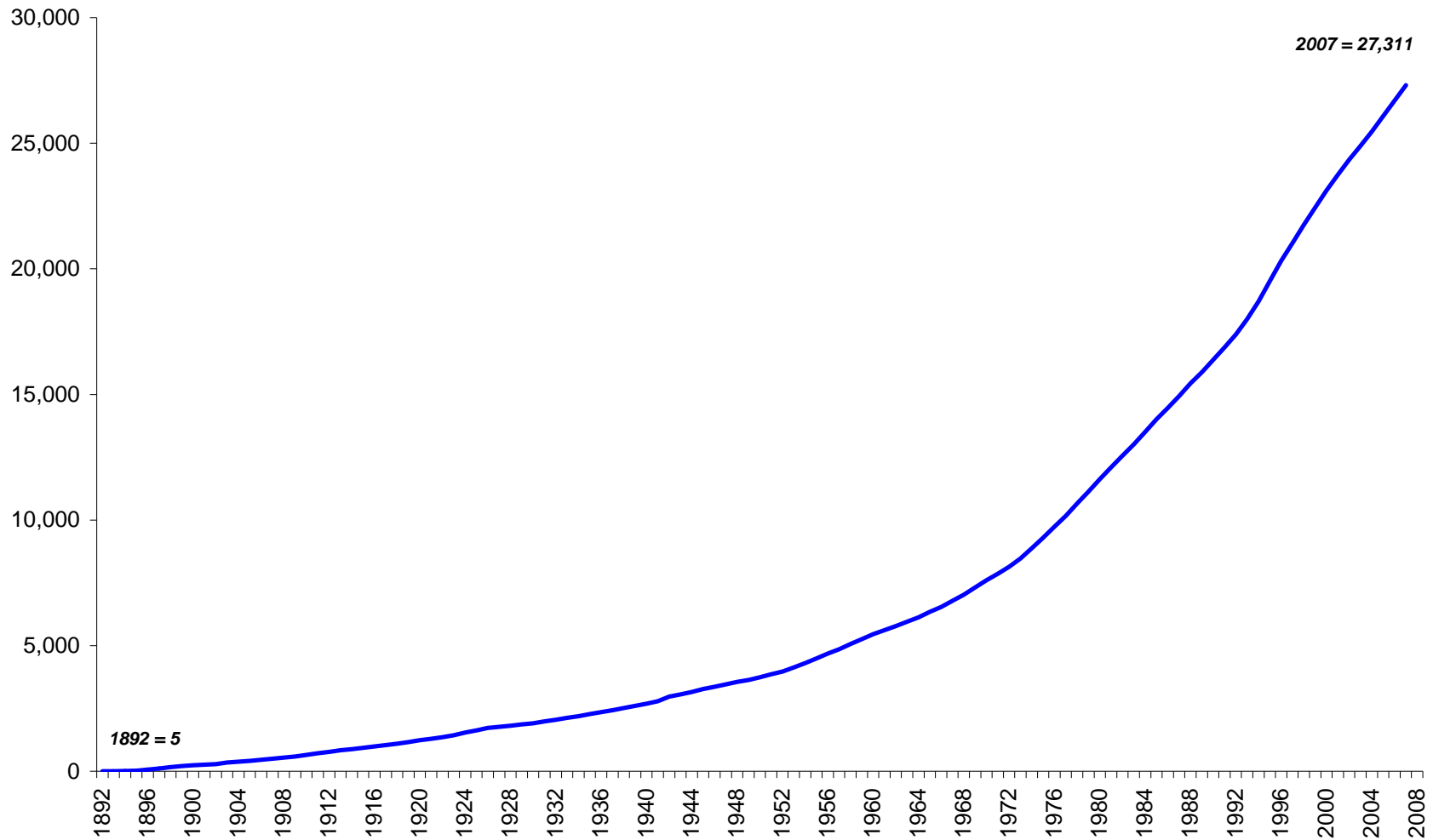

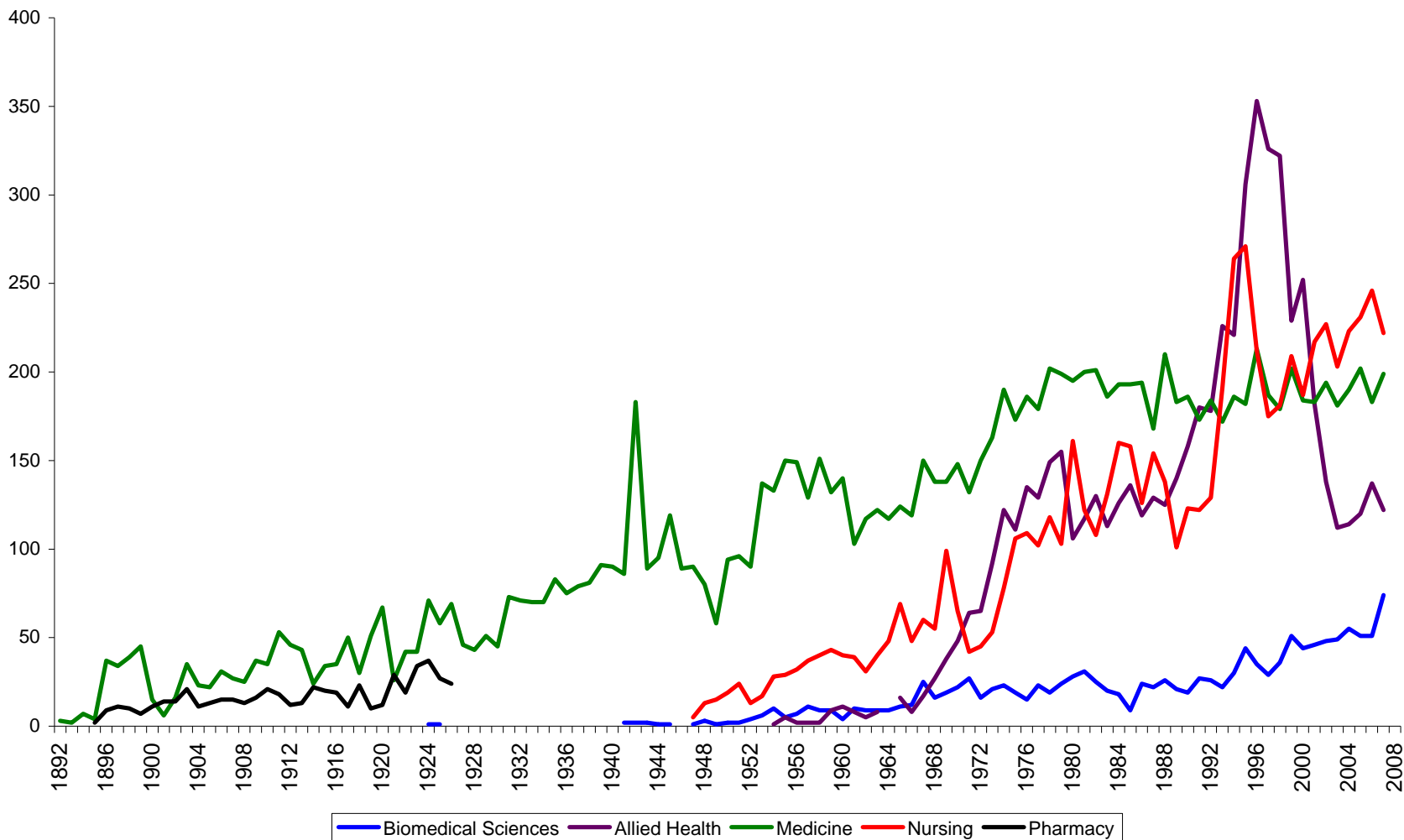
## Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees Conferred 1892–2007 Cumulative Total by Year

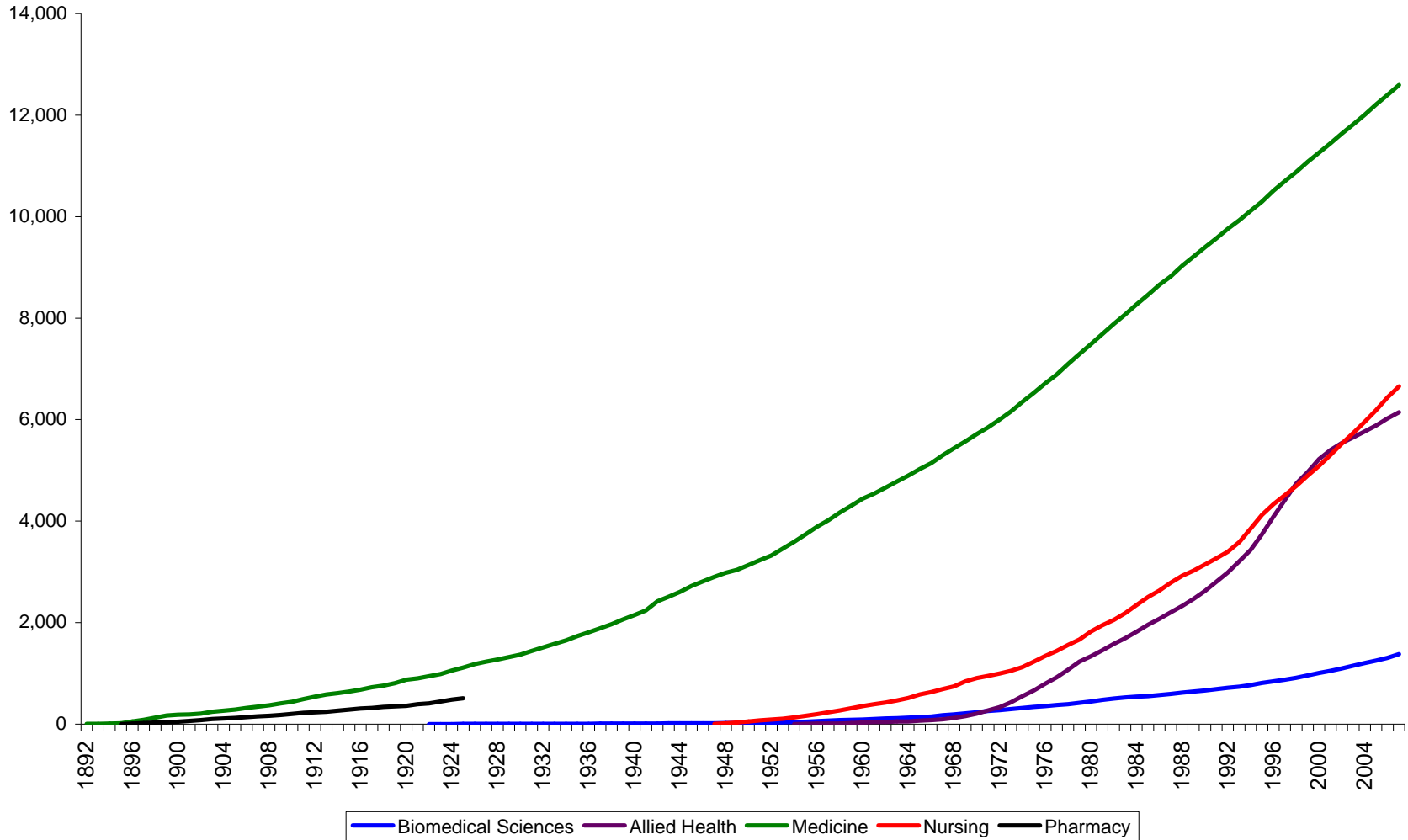
### Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees Conferred By Curricula / School 1892–2007 Cumulative Total = 27,311

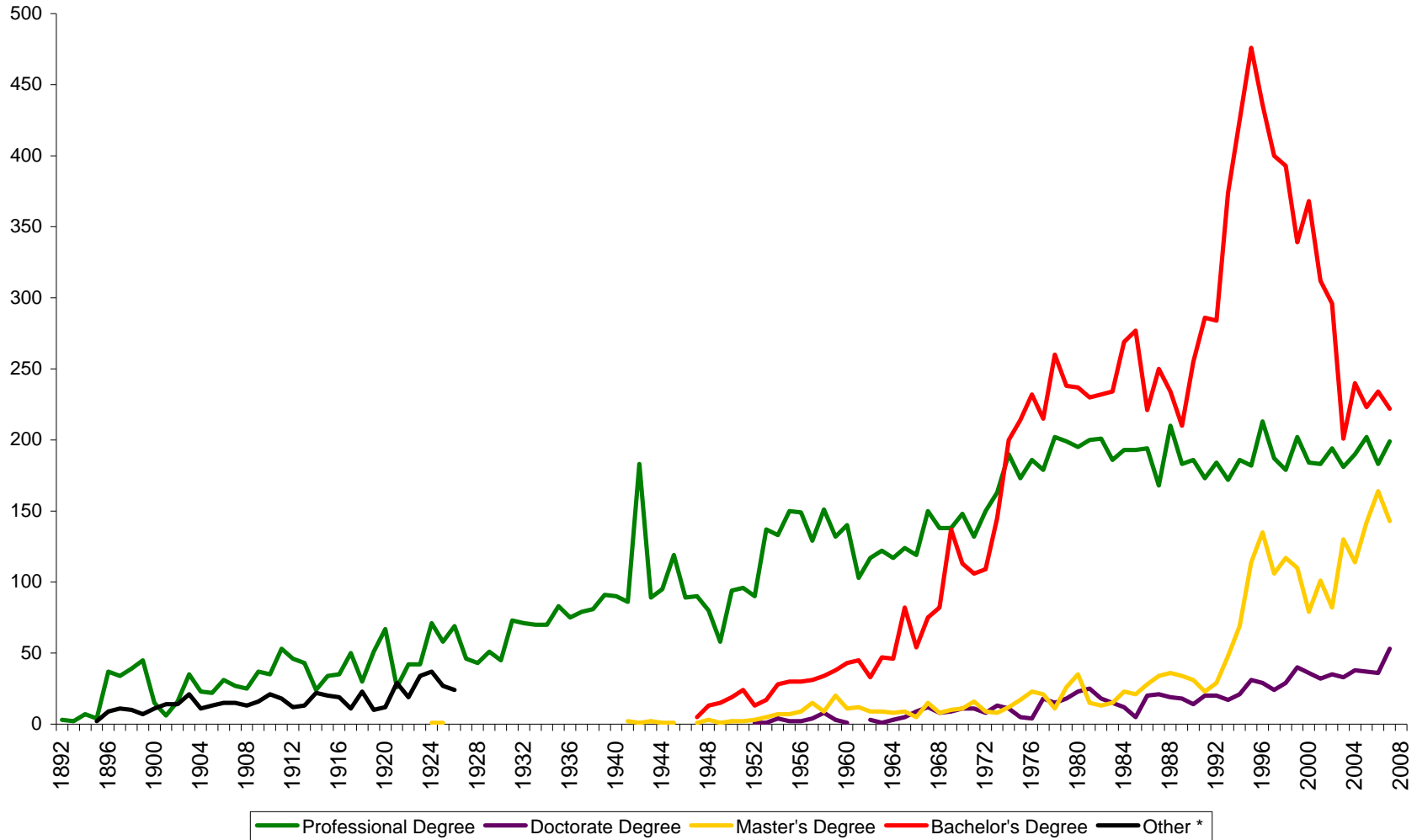

## Estimated Minimum Number of Degrees Conferred By Level 1892–2007

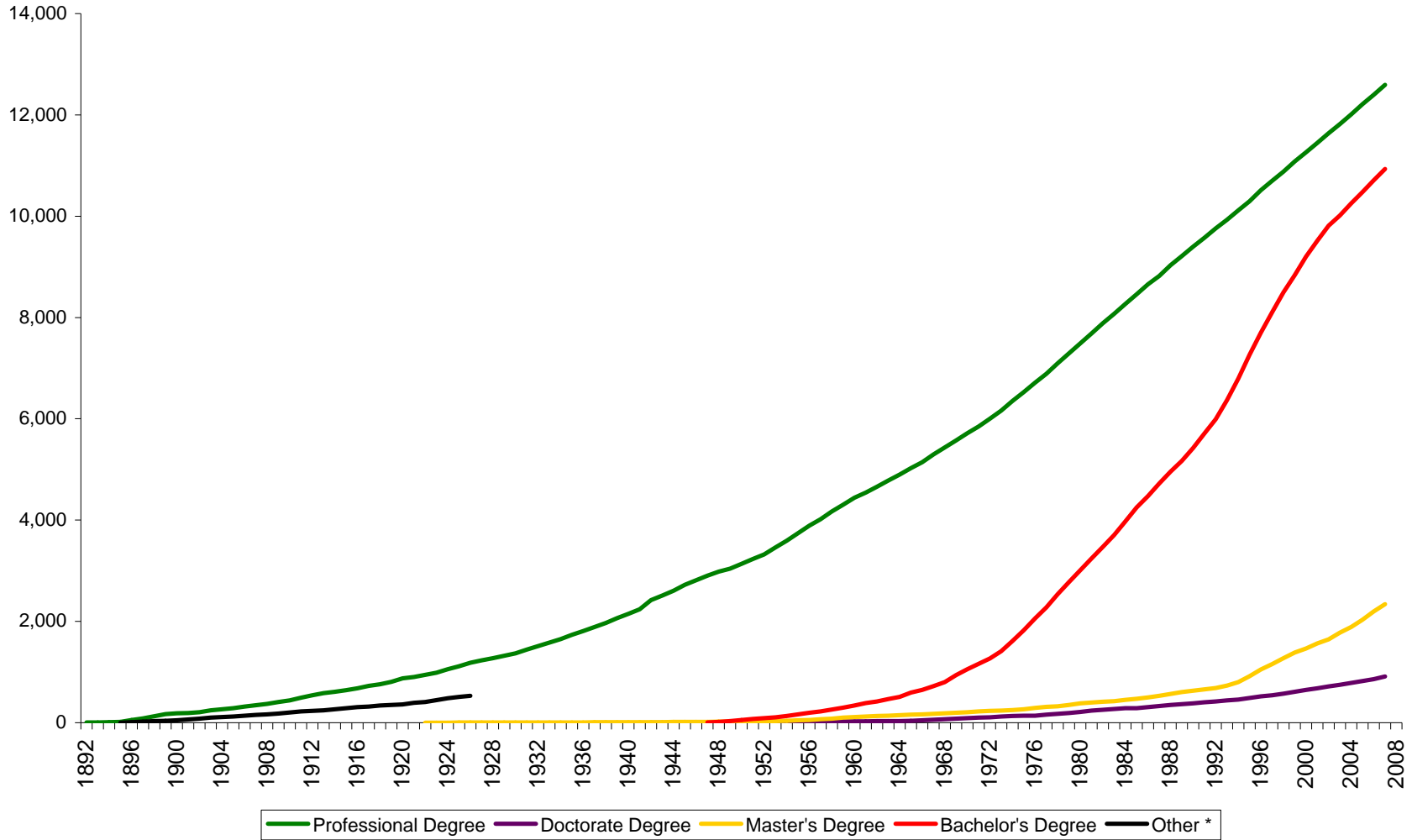
