

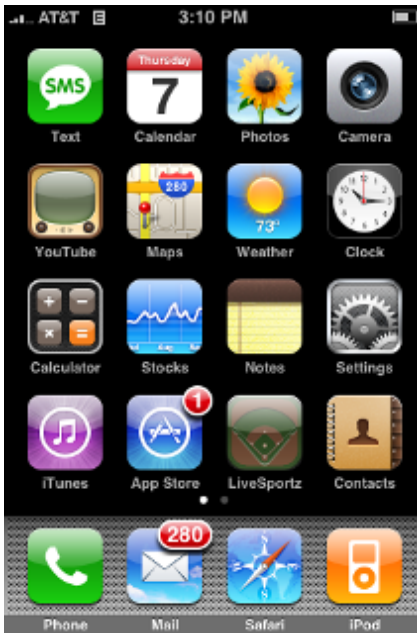
# Configuration for iPhone

With the release of the iPhone software upgrade, wireless mail, calendar and contact synchronization are now possible. The

iPhone ActiveSync configuration uses the same account credentials as when you log in to the web mail client (OWA) at [webmail.utmb.edu](http://webmail.utmb.edu).

From the iPhone Home menu:

1. Select the Settings icon



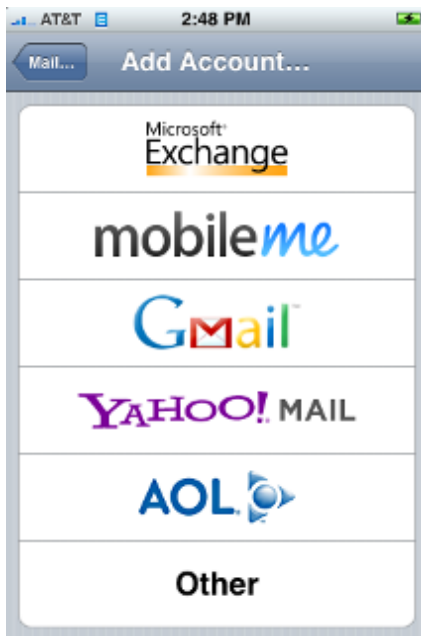
2. Select the "Mail, Contacts, Calendars" option



3. Select the "Add Account..." option



4. Chose the Microsoft Exchange option



5. Fill in the settings as follows:

**On the first screen:**

Email address = **username@utmb.edu**

Username = **username**

Password = **\*\*\*\*\***

Description (any meaningful title you wish to use to identify the account, for example = [username@utmb.edu](mailto:username@utmb.edu))



**On the second screen**

Server name = **mail.utmb.edu**



6. Select what options you want synchronized to your iPhone



**Functions that are NOT supported are:**

1. Folder Management
2. Access to file shares or SharePoint sites
3. Task synchronization
4. Creating meeting invitations
5. Message Flagging

**Important to note:**

1. Only one Exchange account can be configured on a device
2. Once you are syncing with Exchange via ActiveSync, you cannot synchronize a personal calendar or address book via iTunes.
