Audience Response Systems (ARS)

Do you want to teach using our ARS (clickers)?

Follow these steps:

1. Finish your Powerpoint presentation
2. Create the question/answer set
3. [Download TurningPoint 5](#) (Legacy version) to the computer you are using to build your presentation
4. Insert questions into the presentation
