Membership Organization Dues

II. Policy

State law only permits the payment of mission-related institutional memberships from state-appropriated funds. Institutional memberships must be in the name of UTMB Health. A written justification and appropriate approval is required as part of the Non-PO voucher process.

The Non-PO voucher documentation must include the completed/signed <u>Institutional Membership</u> <u>Approval form</u>

Individuals may be reimbursed for membership dues in outside organizations from allowable, non-state appropriated funds. In order for individual dues to be eligible for reimbursement, the activity must be deemed as a relevant part of the employee's job responsibilities. The respective area VP approval for reimbursement must be obtained prior to submission for reimbursement. Reimbursement submissions lacking approval from the respective area VP will be returned unpaid.

No payments from any source of funds may be made to political action committees or for political purposes

III. Annual Reporting

UTMB will notify the Legislative Budget Board, the Senate Finance Committee, and the House Appropriations Committee of payment of membership dues to organizations having employees required to register as lobbyists pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Texas Government Code.
