01.15 - Hospital Visitation

Purpose To decrease transmission of communicable diseases from visitors to patients

at UTMB

Audience All employees of UTMB hospitals and clinics, contract workers, volunteers, and

students

• Nursing staff shall discourage visitation by persons with any evidence of an acute infection.

 Visitors shall be instructed on handwashing and other guidelines before they visit a patient in isolation.

 Nursing personnel are responsible for instructing visitors and patients in proper isolation techniques and monitoring compliance with specified techniques.

• Visitation may be restricted during an influx of community infection.

- Visitation in specialty units, such as ICU, may increase the restrictions in order to care for the critically ill.
- Visitors under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult other than the patient. In some units and during times of higher infection risks, additional precautions or restrictions may be implemented for visiting minors.
- Overnight visitation is allowed at the discretion of the unit charge nurse based on patient need and/or request. Visitors of patients may be authorized to remain in public waiting areas overnight by the unit charge nurse.
