

Instructions for Printing Cage Cards

This graphic file is very likely to print a different size cage card on different printers. Check to see whether the cage card prints in a 3"x5" area. If not, you will need to adjust the size of the document. Failure to adjust the size may result in cage cards that cannot fit into the 3"x5" cage card holders. There are 3 cage cards (2 identical cards for weaned mice and 1 mating cage card) included in this graphic file.

A. For MacIntosh computers:

Go to page set up (File menu) and change the scale. Print page 2 of the document and determine whether the cage cards fit entirely in a 3"x5" area. If not, change the scale again and reprint to determine the size of the card. If you are running system software 7.5, unclick "Scale to size" within the page setup settings. Once you have the proper size, you can print the document and bring the graphic printout to Biocommunications for printing of the cards. Instruct them that you would like 3"x5" index cards (cut to size).

B. For PCs (Windows 95/98):

Go to print setup under the file menu. Click properties. Click graphics. Adjust the scaling up or down (Try 95% if the graphic is too big.). Click apply. Click OK. Click OK. Print page 2 of the document and determine whether the cage card fits entirely in a 3"x5" area. If not, change the scale again and reprint to determine the size of the card. Once you have the proper size, you can print the document and bring the graphic printout to Biocommunications for printing of the cards. Instruct them that you would like 3"x5" index cards (cut to size).

If all else fails, we can print the graphic file for you!!!
