The successful candidate will join a very active and well funded group of investigators on aging, and will enjoy a collegial environment with ample opportunities for interdisciplinary collaborations including: the UTMB Claude D. Pepper Older Americans Independence Center; the Sealy Center on Aging; the Institute for Translational Sciences/CTSA; several institutional training grants; and a research-oriented Acute Care for Elders Units, which has been recently designated as an inpatient research unit for clinical and translational studies on hospitalized older patients. UTMB is located approximately 50 miles south of Houston, on the scenic Gulf Coast, and has several ongoing partnerships with other academic institutions in the Houston-Galveston region, which provide additional opportunities for networking and collaborations.

The ideal candidate will have a nationally-recognized scholarly publication record and extramural funding, a history of successful pre- and/or post-doctoral mentoring, and be willing to significantly contribute to the vibrant interdisciplinary research and research training activities at UTMB.
