Listed below is a partial outline of common procedures we perform in the areas of abdomen, chest and head and neck.

Abdomen:

- Gastroesophageal reflux
- Appendicitis
- Hypertrophic pyloric stenosis
- Inflammatory bowel disease
- Splenic conditions
- Liver mass
- Renal, Adrenal mass
- Esophagogastroduodenoscopy
- Foreign body ingestion

Congenital Surgical Anomalies:

- Intestinal atresia
- Intestinal malrotation/Midgut volvulus
- Abdominal wall defects (Omphalocele, Gastroschisis)
- Hirschsprung's disease
- Imperforate anus
- Tracheoesophageal fistula
- Congenital diaphragmatic hernia
- Pulmonary lesions (lobar sequestration, cystic adenomatoid malformation)
- Necrotizing enterocolitis

Head and Neck:

- Thyroid mass
- Thyroglossal duct cyst
- Branchial cleft cyst
- Cystic hygroma

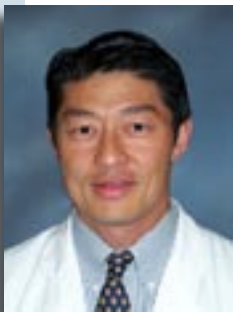
Thorax:

- Empyema
- Pulmonary mass
- Mediastinal mass
- Chest wall deformities (Pectus Excavatum, Pectus Carinatum)
- Bronchoscopy
