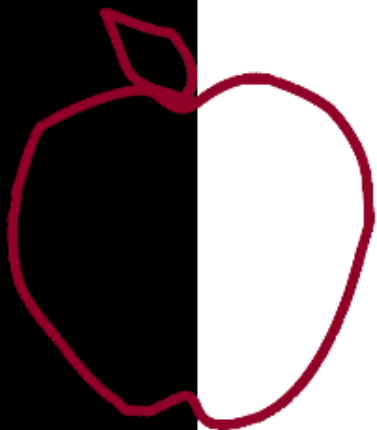




HERB & DRUG INTERACTIONS

FEVERFEW

COMMON INDICATIONS

- Treatment of arthritis
- The prevention and treatment of migraines and associated nausea and vomiting

SIDE EFFECTS

Potential sensitization to skin contact with the drug.

DRUG INTERACTION

May interact with blood thinners such as aspirin, Coumadin® or Warfarin®.
