**Vascular**

**Open surgical repair of aortic, subclavian and iliac artery aneurysms or occlusions and real artery bypass.**

**Angioplasty** (intravascular dilation technique)  
**Endovascular stenting** (placement of tube into blood vessel to open it) of any portion of the aorta, iliac or carotid artery or other (peripheral) arteries or veins

**Vascular thrombolysis** (removal or dissolving of blood clots - percutaneous (mechanical or chemical)).  
**Angiography with occlusion techniques** (including embolization and sclerosis) - therapeutic  
**Mesenteric angiography** with infusion therapy (Vasopressin) for gastrointestinal bleeding  
**Inferior vena caval filter insertion & removal**  
**Pulmonary angiography**  
**Percutaneous treatment of pseudoaneurysm** (percutaneous thrombin injection versus

compression.

**Varicose vein treatment** - percutaneous via laser, RFA, chemical, w/o angiography

**Vascular access** - nontunneled catheters, tunneled catheters, implanted

***Cholecystectomy with or without common bile duct exploration***

#### ***Eye Treatments and Procedures 6506***

***Eye muscle surgery***

***Surgery for cataract with or w/o implantation of intraocular lens.***

***Retinal or vitreous surgery.***

***Reconstructive and/or plastic surgical procedures of the eye and eye region, such as blepharoplasty, tumor, fracture. Lacrimal, foreign body, abscess or trauma***

***Photocoagulation and/or cryotherapy***

***Corneal surgery such as corneal transplant, refractive surgery & pterygium***

***Glaucoma surgery by any method***

***Removal of the eye or its contents (enucleation or evisceration)***

***Surgery for penetrating ocular injury including intraocular foreign body***

### **Female Genital System Treatments and Procedures 6507**

**Abdominal hysterectomy (total)**

**Vaginal hysterectomy**

**All fallopian tub and ovarian surgery with or w/o hysterectomy including removal and lysis of adhesions**

**Removing fibroids (uterine myomectomy)**

**Uterine Suspension**

**Removal of the nerves to the uterus (presacral neurectomy)**

**Removal of cervix**

**Repair of vaginal hernia (anterior and/or posterior colporrhaphy and/or enterocele repair)**

**Abdominal suspension of the bladder (retropubic urethropexy)**

**Conization of Cervix**

**Dilation and Curettage of uterus (diagnostic/therapeutic)**

### **Musculoskeletal System Treatments and Procedures 6512**

**Arthroplasty of any joints with mechanical device**

*All other orthopedic procedures with children age 12 and under*

*Vertebroplasty/kyphoplasty*

#### ***Nervous System Treatments and Procedures 6513***

*Craniotomy, craniectomy or cranioplasty*

*Cranial nerve operations*

*Spine operation including laminectomy, decompression, fusion, internal fixation or procedures for nerve root or spinal cord compression, diagnosis, pain, deformity, mechanical instability, injury, removal of tumor, abscess or hematoma (excluding coccygeal operations)*

*Peripheral nerve operation, nerve grafts, decompression, transposition or tumor removal, neuroorrhaphy, neurectomy or neurolysis*

*Transphenoidal hypophysectomy or other pituitary gland operation*

*Cerebral spinal fluid shunting procedure or revision*

#### ***Radiology 6514***

*Splenoportography (needle injection of contrast media in the spleen)*

*Chemoembolization*

*Radioembolization*

*Thermal and other ablative techniques for treatment of tumors (for curative intent or palliation) including radiofrequency ablation, cryoablation and high intensity focused ultrasound (HIFU), irreversible electroporation*

*TIPS (Transjugular Intrahepatic Portosystemic Shunt) and its variants such as DIPS (Direct Intrahepatic Portocaval Shunt)*

*Myelography*

*Percutaneous abscess/fluid collection drainage (percutaneous abscess/seroma/lymphocele drainage and/or sclerosis (including percutaneous transgluteal transrectal and trans vaginal routes)*

*Procedures utilizing prolonged fluoroscopy*

#### ***Respiratory System Treatments and Procedures 6515***

*Biopsy and/or excision of lesion or larynx, vocal cords, trachea*

*Rhinoplasty or nasal reconstruction with or without septoplasty.*

*Submucous resection of nasal septum or nasal septoplasty*

*Lung Biopsy*

*Segmental resection of lung*

*Thoracotomy*

*Thoracotomy with drainage*

**Urinary System 6516**

*Partial nephrectomy (removal of part of the kidney)*

*Radical nephrectomy (removal of kidney and adrenal gland for cancer)*

*Nephrectomy (removal of kidney)*

*Nephrolithotomy and pyelolithotomy (removal of kidney stones)*

*Pyeloureteroplasty (pyeloplasty or reconstruction of the kidney drains)*

*Exploration of kidney or perinephric mass*

*Ureteroplasty (reconstruction of ureter)*

*Ureterolithotomy (surgical removal of stones from ureter)*

*Ureterectomy (partial or complete removal of ureter)*

*Ureterolysis (partial/complete removal of ureter between kidney , bladder and adjacent tissue)*

*Prostatectomy (partial or total replacement of prostate)*

*Total cystectomy (removal of the urinary bladder).*

*Radical cystectomy*

*Partial cystectomy (partial removal of bladder)*

*Urinary diversion (ileal conduit, conon conduit)*

*Ureterosigmoidostomy (placement of kidney drainage tubes into the large bowel - intestine)*

*Urethroplasty (construction/reconstruction of drainage tube from bladder.*

*Endoscopic surgery of the thorax (there are additional risks and hazards of the same surgery as when performed as an open procedure)*

***Pain Management Procedures 6520***

*Neuroaxial procedures (injections into or around the spine)*

*Peripheral and visceral nerve blocks and/or ablations*

*Implantation of pain control devices*
